

PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY & MUSEUMS



Arguably one of the most famous people to call Fremont home was Rutherford B. Hayes, the 19th president of the United States. He was a lawyer who practiced primarily in Cincinnati, Ohio. When the Civil War began, Hayes joined the military and rose to the rank of major general. He was eventually elected Congress and became governor of the State of Ohio in 1867. In 1873, several years before becoming president, he moved his family to a home in Fremont called Spiegel Grove. It was here that Hayes and his wife, Lucy, retired to after serving as president. Both of them passed away at the mansion and are buried on property. Also on the 25-acre estate is the first presidential library in the nation and a newly renovated museum housing many of Hayes' artifacts. The home, museum, library and grounds are open year-round for locals and visitors alike to enjoy.
















TARITACES on the Sandusky River

It's 11:15 pm on a warm, summer evening and the long day has given way to the full moon now peaking over the tree line. I paddle my kayak down the Sandusky River. I am with a group of other river kayak enthusiasts who have also chosen to make a full moon paddle with me this evening.

Suddenly I see movement in the darkness ahead of me. My heart races as I hear a growl ahead. At first, I contemplate fighting the current to paddle backwards, but it is no use, as the current is just too strong. It is inevitable ... whatever is lurking in the river ahead of me is my fate! Now just feet away, standing at the edge of the riverbank is a large ape-like creature. I yell out "BIGFOOT" as I rocket past it. The beast has now locked eyes on our group and a guttural growl erupts from it. Welcome to GHOUL RUNNINGS, a Kayak Adventure business that offers guided

and self-guided tours down the scenic Sandusky River and beautiful Fremont Reservoir. What I have just described is their Bigfoot-themed Full-Moon paddle that is repeated each lunar cycle with a different villain or creature each time. From Jason to Zombies, mythical creatures are waiting to frighten, yet entertain,

the adventurous kayaker each voyage.

Owner Beth Turner and her husband Bob have been running a haunted attraction each fall for the past thirty-two years known as the "Haunted Hydro." The 1910 Hydro Electric Power Plant was fully operational until the mid-1940's. Their love for Halloween and the outdoors has created this "bizarre marriage" of kayaking and ghouls.

Opening in May each year, Ghoul Runnings, LLC offers guided and self-guided tours which include safety and training classes. A variety of two and four-hour trips and specialty adventures include: a history tour, singles kayaking group and other outings such as bird and nature, sunset, moonlight and more. Ghoul Runnings may soon be starting some competitive events which could include fishing derbies, speed and maneuverability, krazy-kraft kayak event and more.

Online event tickets and onsite sales are available through its website www.GhoulRunnings.com and at the business location, "Yak-Shack", which is located at the Fremont Reservoir across the road from the "A-Frame" rental location, 1773 South River Road, Fremont, Ohio 43420. The Adventures run May through September, weather permitting.

Historic Jail & Dungeon Whispers of a Dark Past

For most residents of Fremont, Ohio the Sandusky County Courthouse is nothing more than another ordinary county building. However, there is dark history that refuses to be silenced. In the early 1840s, local officials often struggled to keep inmates contained in their above-ground jails mostly due to primitive constructions that included dirt floors and wooden barriers. Because prisoners often escaped, the county officials build an underground dungeon with solid limestone walls, ceilings and floors that was deemed unescapable. Due to repeated escape attempts from the above-ground jail, a cold-blooded murderer by the name of George Thompson became the dungeon's first resident before the construction of the courthouse above was complete. While being housed in the dungeon, George awaited his execution on the gallows for murdering a young woman.

Prisoners saw little daylight in the subterranean space, with the only illumination coming from kerosene lamps or candles. Despite the terrible conditions, the dungeon was used for more than a decade before it was finally shuttered. "It's like stepping through a time portal. When you open that door and go into the dungeon area, it literally feels like you stepped back into the 1840s," says David Thornbury, marketing specialist at the Sandusky County Convention & Visitors Bureau, which oversees tours of the jail and dungeon. There are many stories of murder and mayhem that landed individuals on death row here. It's easy to see why the dungeon was only used for a short period of time; people just didn't do well being kept in those conditions. Also, that type of imprisonment was not in line with the young Christian country that America was trying to become.

Residents may say it is most known for Winesburg, Ohio and



Smaller Communities

Green Springs - On a beautiful autumn day, the trees along State Route 19 are ablaze with deep reds, shimmering golden yellows and pumpkin oranges. The town of Green Springs, located in the southern section of Sandusky County, is enveloped in a peaceful quietness, interrupted only by the sound of crisp leaves blowing. Green Springs "claim to fame" is that it has the largest natural sulfur springs in the world, a beautiful pond-like setting located on the west side of town. The mineral spring flows from an underground river, down Green Creek, into the Sandusky Bay and Lake Erie.

One of the highlights of the village is the Stemtown Historical Society Museum which is in the home of Allen Watrous who was the only Revolutionary War Veteran from Green Springs. Other attractions include R-Bar-D Stables LLC Tack & Village Store for general store items and horse supplies, Jimmie's BBQ, a village store and the Green Springs Village Park which includes play equipment, picnic area, tennis and basketball courts.

Helena - Even though the village of Helena, located on State Route 6, is small, it has some wonderful attributes. People come from all around the state to visit Chateau Tebeau Winery, located just off the highway on State Route 635. Nestled in a country setting, this beautiful winery features award-winning wines produced from grapes grown on the property. During the warm months, guests enjoy sitting by the koi pond or strolling through the vineyard. The winter months offer a cozy place to relax by the massive stone fireplace in the tasting room.

Another popular destination is The Summer Kitchen on State Route 6. Upon stepping inside, visitors feel enchanted with the delightful mixture of home décor, floral arrangements, teas, baking mixes and much more!

Lindsey - One of the most popular destinations in Lindsey is Wilson Nature Center at Creek Bend Farm. Originally an 1850's farm owned by Philip and Margaret Overmyer, it remained in their family until it was acquired in 2002 by the Sandusky County Park District with the help of the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund Grant and a donation by the Roush family. At that time, the farm belonged to Frances and Robert Roush and is now listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The Nature Center opened in 2004 following a generous donation by Sharon and Joe Wilson, as well as a capital campaign. Inside the Center, visitors enjoy a Window on Wildlife room, animal displays, a nature library and educational classrooms. Two miles of Muddy Creek runs through the property, as well as three miles of hiking trails. The property also contains a floodplain where bird enthusiasts can observe migrating warblers, water birds and bald eagles.

Running through the village is the North Coast Inland Trail which offers 21.6 miles of completed, paved trails throughout the county. Also at this location is a children's park with various playground options.



Camping

Camping has long been a favorite hobby of many families. It permits the average person to escape their "normal life," find a spacious, often wooded area, set up a tent or camper and "survive" in the wilderness for a few days. It allows for an absence from the hectic lifestyle so many of us lead, to a more relaxed, laid-back experience where we reconnect with the land.

Sandusky County offers a number of diverse options for camping in our area. Whether guests are looking for a campsite on the serene Sandusky River or a wooded site surrounded by firs, oaks and hemlocks, we've got it! Enjoy some of the county's best hiking trails along with lake or quarry swimming, family activities and much more. Many campgrounds in the area offer both full hookup and primitive sites. Some even offer cabins, cottage rentals and boat launches. Sandusky County campgrounds offer a back-to-nature option to our many hotels as a place to set up base camp and explore the region.



The Spring Run

The Sandusky River in Fremont, Ohio, as well as several of the area's reservoirs and other bodies of water, offer numerous outstanding fishing opportunities. While the spring run is the most popular fishing opportunity, good fishing abounds all year throughout the county. With many parks and public access areas, Sandusky County is truly an angler's paradise!

For generations, sport fishermen from across the United States have flocked to the Sandusky River each spring to take part in the walleye and white bass spring run fishing phenomenon. The spring run is known for producing some of the largest walleye taken from Lake Erie each year. The most consistent success on spring walleye usually occurs in the deep pools that line the Sandusky River between the State Street and Miles Newton Bridges in Fremont. Another popular spot is River Cliff Park on Tiffin Street in Fremont. Favorite gear for landing these thrashing lunkers among the rocks is a medium-weight spinning rod and ten-pound test line. From March 1 through May 1, lures are restricted to those with single hooks so lead head jigs in a variety of weights and bright colors are the universal favorite. The actual start date depends on the water temperature so dates may vary

Birdand Watching

The bird migration superhighway

Sandusky County is located along the bird migration superhighway. This gives Sandusky County the opportunity to see many species of exotic and colorful birds as they make their way across the country to their breeding grounds in Canada. They spend their summers up north and then fly as far away as South America in the winter.

The Sandusky County Park District system is one of the leading locations for birders of every level, whether beginners or experts. Great birding spots include the Blue Heron Reserve, which is part of the Lake Erie Birding Trail, White Star Park, Wolf Creek, Creek Bend Farm, River Cliff Park, Pickerel Creek Wildlife Area and all along the shores of the scenic Sandusky River.

Each spring, neighboring Ottawa County and the Black Swamp Bird Observatory host "The Biggest Week in American Birding" with a 10-day festival held in "The Warbler Capital of the World". The festival celebrates the peak of the spring migration with birding events and hotspots at the world-famous Magee Marsh and the Lake Erie Marsh Region of northwest Ohio. This year's "Biggest Week" takes place May 6-15, 2022.

Both Sandusky County and Ottawa County recorded the largest number of bald eagle nests across Ohio with 140 nests between the counties according to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources 2020 nest census. Boat rides and strolls along the Sandusky River regularly reveal copious eagle spottings. In the 1970's, eagles were nearly extinct with only four breeding pairs left across the entire state. Today, Ohio has over 700 confirmed bald eagle nests, with all but three counties in the state containing

A very active place to see the American Bald Eagle in Sandusky County is along the Sandusky River. A cruise on the river during peak summer months can reveal up to 60 sightings of this once endangered and majestic bird!

An excellent Bald Eagle watching location is River Cliff Park, located on the Sandusky River at 1329 Tiffin Street in Fremont.

Birding by Month

Tanuary

Midwinter brings small visitors from the north. They find shelter in meadows, woodlands and marshes. You can find a variety of waterfowl wherever there is an opening in the river, bay or lake ice.

7ebruary

The moderate temperatures in the last half of the month bring the first robins, killdeer, woodcocks and blackbirds.

March

After the frozen marshes begin to thaw, the flights of migrating waterfowl begin. Early flights of pintails, mallards, tundra, swans, black ducks and many others follow the freeze line.

April

Spring migration increases in intensity, bringing over 300 species of birds to the area. A large number of raptors, the first waves of shorebirds and a wide variety of songbirds appear.

May

Warbler-mania strikes! Many species of these colorful songbirds come to the area to rest and refuel before continuing their journey.

Tune

Nesting season begins. Each bird finds its favorite habitat (field, thicket, tree-top, marsh). Birding is at its best as the last of the shorebirds are heading north.

July

Singing begins to wane; nesters are busy nesting. The first southbound sandpipers and plovers appear.

August

The height of migration from south-bound shorebirds takes place on mudflats or marshes of any kind.

September

The warblers return in large numbers in the fall. However, they're quieter and duller in color.

October

Indians called this the "Month of sparrows" in weed patches everywhere. A few you might see are the white-throated sparrow, swamp sparrow and the fox sparrow.

November

Migrant songbirds have mostly cleared out. Huge flocks of Bonaparte's gulls and red-breasted mergansers invade. Marshes can be thick with waterfowl.

December

Winter sets in and shorter days sometimes bring boreal songbirds.




